Marianne Sciucco has been a member of Middletown Thrall Library for more than twenty years. A native of Brockton, Massachusetts, she moved to Middletown in 1991, became a nurse, and married lifelong resident Lou Sciucco. They are the parents of Allison Sciucco. Marianne worked as a nurse at Horton Hospital/Orange Regional Medical Center for many years and currently works as a campus nurse at Orange County Community College, Middletown campus. Her love of words and books led her to fulfill a lifelong dream to one day write and publish her own book. In 2013, she independently published her debut novel *Blue Hydrangeas, an Alzheimer's love story*. Her second novel, *Swim Season*, is scheduled for release November 1st. Marianne teaches several classes in independent publishing at Orange County Community College and Mount Saint Mary College. She has presented programs at the library and helps coordinate the Local Authors and Illustrators Showcase, which has become an annual event. She holds a Bachelor's Degree in English from the University of Massachusetts at Boston, is a graduate of the Licensed Practical Nurse program at Orange Ulster BOCES, and received an Associate in Applied Science from Regents College, now Excelsior, in Albany, and became a registered nurse. Her goal as a trustee is to help build a vibrant literary community for the Thrall Public Library District of Middletown and Wallkill, to foster a love of reading and learning, and to see that the community has the tools and resources it needs to reach its full potential.
