THRALL STATISTICS FOR 2020

The Library's usage statistics were significantly impacted by the COVID-19 global pandemic. From March 13, 2020 through December 31, 2020, public access to the Library building was restricted or prohibited in response to local health advisories to protect the health and safety of the general public.
