

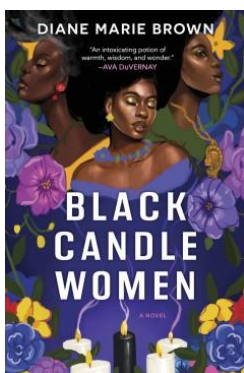

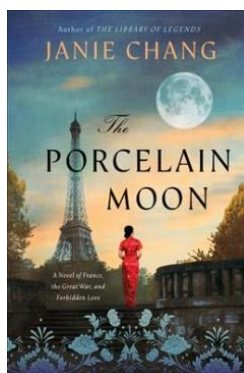

by Diane Marie Brown

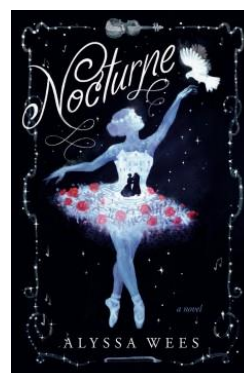

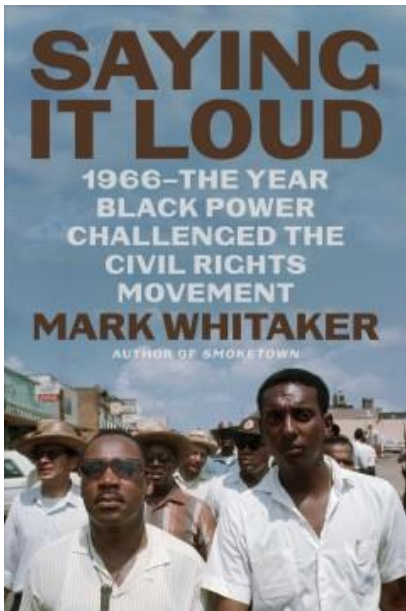

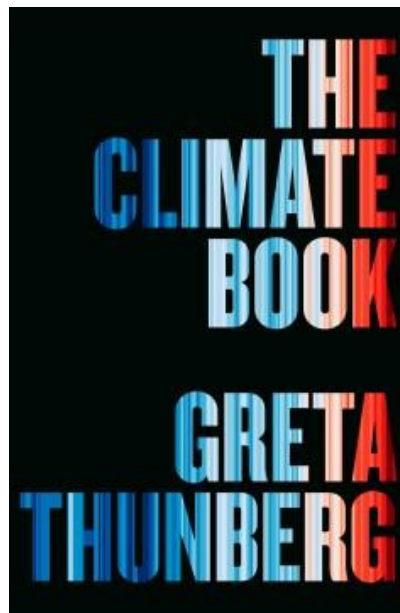
