

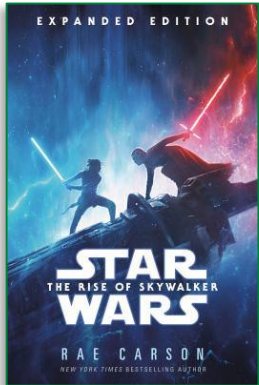

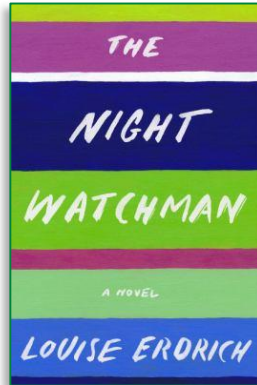

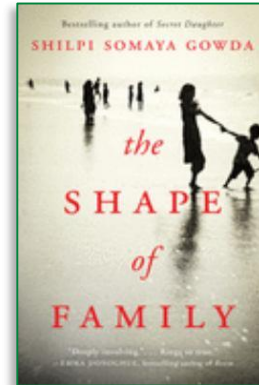
The Rise of Skywalker by Rae Carson

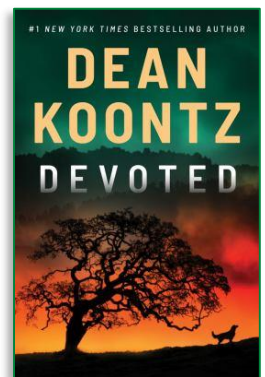

Koontz's latest novel, **Devoted**, is described as "an epic thriller about a terrifying threat to humanity and the singular compassion it will take to defeat it."

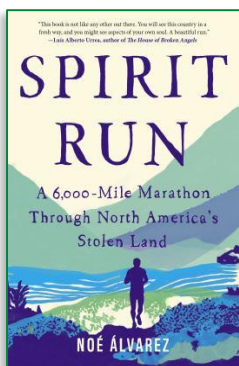

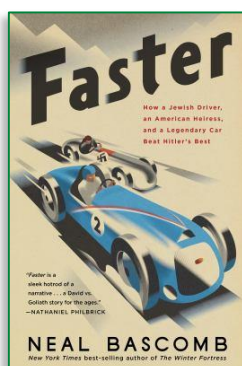

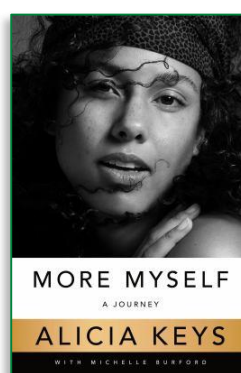

Faster

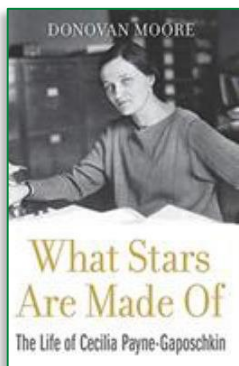

Nonfiction Spotlight: Dan Abrams

In addition to serving as "the chief legal affairs anchor" for ABC News, Abrams is a nonfiction writer whose works mainly focus on pivotal litigation involving U.S. Presidents:

Lincoln's Last Trial: The Murder Case That Propelled Him to the Presidency

Theodore Roosevelt for the Defense: The Courtroom Battle to Save His Legacy

Abrams' latest book, which he co-authored with David Fisher, is **John Adams Under Fire: The Founding Father's Fight for Justice in the Boston Massacre Murder Trial**. In it, these authors "draw on the trial transcript, using Adams's own words to transport readers to colonial Boston, a city roiling with rebellion, where British military forces and American colonists lived side by side, waiting for the spark that would start a war."
